



## TEMPORARY SHOWCASE BASKETBALL COVID-19 GUIDELINES—UPDATED FEBRUARY 3, 2022

The rules set forth below are in conjunction with YMCA and LA County guidelines:

### Location

- All Showcase programming is allowed to resume inside the YMCA gyms

### Coaches

- All coaches must wear a mask at all times
- All coaches must wash hands or use hand sanitizer before and after each training
- All coaches must maintain 6 feet of distance from others when not training
- All coaches are vaccinated and therefore do not require weekly testing
- Training sessions will be designed to ensure safety measures are enforced

### Players

- All players must wear a mask at all times
- All players must wash hands or use hand sanitizer before and after each training
  - For camps, players will have their temperature taken upon entry
- All players must maintain 6 feet of distance from others when not training
- All players must provide a weekly test showing a negative result for Covid-19 unless:
  - A player can provide proof of vaccination
  - A player can provide proof of recovering from Covid-19 within the past 90 days

### Parents/Spectators

- Maximum 2 guests per participating child allowed in the gym during trainings, practices, or games
  - Guests include parents, siblings, extended family, friends, and/or any other person who accompanies the child to the gym
  - All parents, spectators, and guests must wear a mask covering the mouth and nose at all times, regardless of vaccination status
    - If anyone refuses to wear a mask, the activity taking place at that time will be paused until the person wears a mask or leaves the gym

**We ask everyone to please limit attendance to the gym unless absolutely necessary as we transition in the reopening. We look forward to a full reopening in the future and can't wait to welcome all family and friends back in the gym!**
