



LEGACY LEAGUE – LEAGUE RULES – 3v3

Season Set-Up:

- 4 teams in division:
 - Season = 12 games per team
 - Tournament =
 - #1 seed places in Championship game and plays winner of Semi-Final
 - #2 seed places in Semi-Final game and plays winner of Quarter-Final
 - #3 and #4 place in Quarter-Final game
 - Single elimination format
- **Tiebreaker:**
 - **If there is a tie in the season standings, the tie breaker will be determined by the winner of the most head-to-head matchups. If head-to-head matchups are the same, the next tiebreaker will be the team with the most wins against the highest seeded team.**

How to win a game:

- Winner of the game is determined by the final score on the scoreboard.

Rosters:

- Eligibility:
 - Admittance to Legacy League is determined by the Showcase coaching staff and by invitation only. Invitations can only be sent out when an opening in the League becomes available.
 - If a player removes themselves from Legacy League, their spot will be filled. The player will not be able to re-enter Legacy League until:
 1. A new opening in Legacy League becomes available, and
 2. The player receives an invitation back into Legacy League.
 - The following criteria are used in evaluating who receives an invitation to Legacy League:
 1. The player has completed a minimum of one (1) season at the Showcase Cup level.
 2. The player has showcased excellence in the values prioritized at the Cup level, including, but not limited to, culture, sportsmanship, coachability, and teamwork.
 3. The player has showcased the intangibles promoted at the Cup level, including, but not limited to, effort (motor), a “next play” mindset, and a long-term development focus.
 4. The player has showcased an above average skill set and basketball IQ at the Cup level that the Showcase coaches determine it is in the player’s best interest to be challenged even further.





5. The player's family has showcased an ability to follow the "One Voice" philosophy and demonstrated demeanor promoted at Showcase Basketball, including, but not limited to:
 - Maintaining a positive attitude towards all players, coaches, and referees.
 - Refraining from critiquing, arguing, or displaying negative reactions towards all players, coaches, and referees.
 - Following Showcase Basketball guidelines that are in place to protect the culture of the program.
- Rosters are capped at 5 players per team. There will be three seasons of play:
- "No Shows":
 - Stan, the Sr. Director of Basketball Operations, must be notified directly via email or text if a player will not be able to play in their game. A player who misses a game without notifying Stan is considered a "no show":
 - 1st "No Show" violation = written warning.
 - 2nd "No Show" violation = removal from roster and will not be re-added to the roster until completing a meeting with Coach Stan.
 1. 3rd "No Show" violation = permanent removal from roster.
- Practice "No Shows"
 - Players are required to attend practices during the season to build continuity with their team and learn the coach's system.
 - Similar to a game "No Show", Stan needs to be notified if a player is to miss practice before practice begins. A player who misses a practice without notifying Stan is considered a "No Show", and the same rules apply for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd "No Show" violations.
- Playing Time:
 - All players are required to play a minimum of half the game.

Culture:

- Culture issues in game such as not helping teammates up, not high fiving teammates at the free throw line, not standing to high five teammates on bench, poor body language, bad attitude towards officials, coaching and/or complaining from family, etc. will result in punishments at practice each week. These acts will not be tolerated.

Uniforms:

- All players must be in both their Showcase jersey and shorts. Jerseys must be tucked in to the shorts. Socks must be Showcase issued. Any spandex or undershirts worn by players must be in the same color as the uniform worn AND be one of the following:
 - Showcase/TWELVE branded, or
 - Blank
- Uniform requirements:
 - Home = gold jersey / gold shorts / gold accessories / Showcase socks
 - Away = red jersey / red shorts / red accessories / Showcase socks





- Pre-game technical fouls will be assessed for each player in violation of the uniform policy.
